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hether it may be Coachella with colorful bourgeoning art that accentuates the desert vibes, or Kaaboo replicating Southern California's affection towards stand-up comedy trend, BottleRock shows Napa Valley's true spirit with endless extravagant wines and lavish gourmet delectable. BottleRock has never failed to serve up amazing offerings.

Dubbed as "the fancy Coachella," by retro-funk icon Bruno Mars, BottleRock harmonizes a perfect blend of music with top rated local cuisine. Since Live Nation bought the brand back in 2017, with former owner and founder of Latitude 38 Entertainment still leading, BottleRock this year attracted over 120,000 attendees and thrilled attendees with hand selected local craft beers, abundant wine demonstrations, and the finest culinary Napa Valley has to offer. If any music lover that desires to taste the spirit of Napa, BottleRock is a must place to visit and discover.

Held on Memorial weekend, BottleRock is hosted in the heart of Napa Valley, May 24-26, 2019, featuring the best in live music and hand-selected local chefs including Thomas Keller, owner of 3-starred Michelin French Laundry. KAABOO Del Mar aligns both at the ultimate music, art and food extravaganza By Alison Elsner

Can't we all just get along? Yes, actually, when it comes to music, cuisine, comedy and art. KAABOO Del Mar encourages us to forget all we know about music festivals and embrace this three-day sound voyage that combines rock music and taste-making activities nestled alongside the spectacular San Diego coastline. Back for its fifth year at the flagship venue, KAABOO rolls into town on September 13-15, and tickets are going quickly.







Sponsored by MGM Resorts International along with presenting sponsors Aflac, Coors Light

Corona Extra and USAA, the festival stands out for a myriad of reasons, namely the jaw-dropping line up of performers.

Kings of Leon, Dave Matthews Band and Mumford & Sons will headline, joined by hit-makers including Duran Duran, Sheryl Crow, REO Speedwagon, Maren Morris, The Bangles, Squeeze, The Cult, Black Eyed Peas, Boyz II Men and more, and a special collaboration is planned between Snoop Dogg and Wu-Tang Clan.

Also taking the stage will be OneRepublic, The Revivalists, Edie Brickell & New Bohemians, Lifehouse, Blind Melon, Plain White T's, Cheat Codes, Switchfoot, Des Rocs, Con Brio, Mix Master Mike (of the Beastie Boys) and a special performance from the yet-to-beannounced winner of this year's "American Idol."

Don't expect dust, dirt and grunge. The festival is differentiated by clean, comfortable amenities and an upscale yet down-to-earth vibe. There are no cringeworthy porta potties here, and organizers have made sure there are ample seating areas, restaurants and service plazas,

since no one wants to stand up for hours on end.

KAABOO has also stepped up big time to the culinary food and drink plate, so to speak, with Palate, a sampling of artisanal fare with local and regional delicacies and small-batch specialties. Gourmet treats can be paired with dozens of limited production wines, creative libations and craft beers. The Palate stage presentations are sponsored by S. Pellegrino.

Featured chefs include Michael Mina, Nyesha Arrington and Eduardo Garcia, and samples will be served up from Broad Street Oyster Co., Morton's The Steakhouse, So Rich! Chocolates, Stoked Poke, Bling Bling Dumpling, Oodles of Noodles, The Deli Doctor, Ricky's California Corndog, Wafl Truck and plenty of others. There will also be multiple food trucks and vendors on site with snacks and bevvies available for purchase.

Oh, but there's more. Humor Me is KAABOO's indoor, seated comedy club where guests can chill, chuckle and relax while watching nationally recognized comedians like Wayne Brady, Pete Holmes & Friends, Kevin Smith, Jimmy O. Yang, Tig Notaro, Tom Green, Jen Kirkman,





Cristela Alonzo, Cameron Esposito, Bob Saget, and others. Shows are hosted by MK Paulsen.

There's also a spa and relaxation zone to recharge and be pampered by way of massages, spa treatments, hair styling, fashion consultations and hot shaves. Anyone dealing with a hangover will be relieved to know that there will be IV nutrient therapy treatments - a surefire headache cure - as well as other spa services for both men and women, like derma skin rejuvenation.

For those seeking serenity and enlightenment, the festival brings in visual art exhibits, murals and an art fair, thanks to sponsor Acqua Panna. Visual artists include Dodge Williams, Jaclyn Rose, Freaky Record, Laura Cunningham, Kelsey Overstreet, Erin Yoshi, Santos Orellana, Brady Willmott, Thomas Lockhart III, Katie Newell and many more. Participating galleries cover all the bases, such as Henna Designs by Lindsay, Sniptease, Grayson Studio, Taped Metal Canvas, Viralboa, Sugar Press Art, Sparks Gallery, The San Diego Museum of Art and a full canvas of others. Many of the murals and installation pieces are available for purchase, with pricing available on the festival's website.

There are multiple options for customizing the experience, namely upgrading passes with the Amplify program which offers Hang Five, Hang Ten or the Ultimate Hang package. Benefits, depending on level of upgrade, include backstage mix and mingle with musical artists, private performances with various acts and chefs, preferred seating at the comedy shows, private lounges, golf cart access around the venue, complimentary food and drink and complimentary access to Bask, the Vegas-style pool club that offers DJ sets, flowing cocktails, fun sun and sand games, bathrooms and showers with make-up mirrors and premium cabanas. The high energy pool party allows festivalgoers to enjoy a direct view of the Sunset Cliffs Stage.


more. The Ultimate Hang is the ultradeluxe VIP upgrade, which happens to already be sold out.

production aligns the senses as well as brings people together. The celebration leaves everyone happy and in harmony, serotonin boost included. FestivalAllAccess



growing in scale, artistry and technology over the years. Early on, the art was mostly recycled from the previous year's Burning Man festival. Between 2010 and 2015, the focus shifted from renting pieces to commissioning them. Poetic Kinetics has designed several giant installations, including a snail in 2013 ("Helix Poeticus"), an astronaut in 2014 and 2019 ("Escape Velocity") and a caterpillar that "metamorphosized" into a butterfly in 2015 ("Papilio Merraculous").

As for its auspicious beginnings, Coachella was co-founded by Paul Tollett and Rick Van Santen in 1999 and is organized by Goldenvoice, now a subsidiary of AEG Presents since 2004. The two consecutive three-day weekend performances in April, with the same lineup each weekend, showcase popular and established musical artists as well as emerging artists and reunited groups. Tollett is still the ruler of this empire, but vou can call him President.

Coachella is now one of the largest, most famous and most profitable music festivals in the United States and the world. Each Coachella staged from 2013 to 2015 set new records for attendance and revenues. The 2017 festival was attended by 250,000 people and grossed \$114.6 million, marking the first time a recurring festival grossed over \$100 million. Together, the two festivals had an impact of \$704.75 million in 2016, with \$403.2 million of that upon the Coachella Valley and \$106 million going to businesses in Indio. The city gained \$3.18 million in ticket taxes from the two festivals in 2016.

In 2007, Goldenvoice established the Stagecoach Country Music Festival, on the weekend following both Coachella weekends, featuring just over 50 acts during the three days. In 2012, the festival's 55,000 attendees marked its first sell-out crowd. In 2018, Stagecoach set a new attendance record with 75,000 attendees. Notable performers have included Brad Paisley, Jason Aldean, Kenny Chesney, Brooks and Dunn, Toby Keith, Miranda Lambert, Blake Shelton, Sugarland, Willie Nelson, Eagles, Rascal Flatts, Taylor Swift, Tim McGraw, Carrie Underwood, Keith Urban, Martina McBride, Jerry Lee Lewis, Shania Twain, Carrie Underwood, Luke Bryan and dozens of others.

Stagecoach is the highest-grossing festival centered on country music in the world. Like its Coachella counterpart, the country music fest showcases food and beverages, full bars, local restaurant pop ups and even a BBQ contest. There are plenty of options for enjoying cocktails, and Coachella has the more extensive set up of beer gardens and reserved drinking areas.

The festivals are big business for the city of Indio. As host city, Indio provides police and fire protection, private security, medical services, outside law enforcement and city staff services totaling \$2.77 million for the three weekends in 2012. A curfew is also enforced (1 a.m. on Fridays and Saturdays and midnight on Sundays), imposing a fine of \$1,000 per minute that Goldenvoice must pay for each minute they run over.

Music fans can once again look forward to being greeted by the giant Ferris wheel at both festivals in 2020, with presale tickets already on sale and general admission passes to become available after the more detailed lineup announcements in the winter.


